

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

MEETING OF COUNCIL

February 12, 2018

Mayor O'Callaghan called the City of Union council meeting to order on Monday, February 12, 2018 at 7:30 p.m.

Attendance was taken and the following council members were present: Mayor O'Callaghan, Mrs. Oberer, Mrs. Huggins, Mr. Blackwell, Mrs. Perkins, Mrs. Kyle and Mr. Bruns.

Other city staff members attending the meeting were John Applegate, City Manager, Denise Winemiller, Clerk of Council, and Joe Moore, Law Director.

Mayor O'Callaghan called for a moment of silence.

1. Mayor O'Callaghan asked if there were any additions, corrections, or deletions for the minutes of the January 22, 2018 council meeting.

There were no corrections so Mr. Bruns moved that the minutes be accepted as prepared. Mr. Blackwell seconded the motion. All concurred and the minutes of the January 22, 2018 council meeting were accepted as prepared.

2. Citizen's and Visitor's Comments

There were no comments from the citizens and visitors in the audience.

3. ONE READING – RESOLUTION 18-08 – A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A PROPOSED ADDITIONAL POLICE LEVY FOR THE CITY OF UNION.

Mr. Applegate said both of these resolutions deal with the police and fire/EMS levies that will be on the ballot in May. These resolutions authorize the city to spend money on advertising these issues, sending out flyers, etc. and also shows the city's endorsement of the levies. This action is required by the city's charter.

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Mr. Bruns moved that they have the one and only reading and adopt Resolution 18-08. Mr. Blackwell seconded the motion. All concurred and the motion was passed. Resolution 18-08 was adopted.

4. **ONE READING** – RESOLUTION 18-09 – A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A PROPOSED ADDITIONAL FIRE/EMS LEVY FOR THE CITY OF UNION.

Mayor O’Callaghan said this was the same as 18-08 but this resolution concerned the fire/EMS levy instead of the police.

Mr. Bruns moved that they have the one and only reading and adopt Resolution 18-09. Mr. Blackwell seconded the motion. All concurred and Resolution 18-09 was adopted on the first reading.

5. Open Agenda

Mayor O’Callaghan said his prayers and thoughts were with the families of the Westerville police officers that were killed in the line of duty. The Mayor said we appreciate the people that protect us.

Mayor O’Callaghan asked about the pot holes that were developing this year with all of the freezing and thawing. Mr. Applegate said they were working on them. The Mayor suggested that people be aware of them, keep their tires inflated properly, and don’t speed. He said pot holes could appear very suddenly this time of year.

Mr. Bruns asked about salt for this winter. He said in the past, it has been in short supply and had become very expensive. Mr. Applegate said this year, there has been a good supply and the price is good. He said they have actually

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used more salt this year than the last couple of years. Mr. Bruns said he was glad they were in good shape on the salt supply.

He reminded the council members if they haven't sent in the Ohio Ethics form, they need to do that.

Since Mr. Applegate said there was no need for another meeting in February, Mr. Bruns moved that the second meeting in February be cancelled. Mr. Blackwell seconded the motion. All concurred and the motion was passed.

Mrs. Winemiller said the January Fund Balance Sheet had been provided to the council.

6. Mr. Bruns moved that the February 12, 2018 council meeting be adjourned. Mr. Blackwell seconded the motion. All concurred and the meeting was adjourned.

The next council meeting will be March 12, 2018.
