MEETING OF COUNCIL

November 13, 2018

Mayor O'Callaghan called the City of Union council meeting to order on Tuesday, November 13, 2018 at 7:30 p.m.

Attendance was taken and the following council members were present: Mayor O'Callaghan, Mr. Blackwell, Mrs. Perkins, Mrs. Kyle, Mrs. Oberer, Mrs. Huggins, and Mr. Bruns.

Other city staff members attending the meeting were John Applegate, City Manager, Denise Winemiller, Clerk of Council, and Joe Moore, Law Director.

Mayor O'Callaghan called for a moment of silence.

1. Mayor O'Callaghan asked if there were any additions, corrections, or deletions for the minutes of the October 9, 2018 council meeting.

There were no corrections so Mr. Bruns moved that the minutes be accepted as prepared. Mr. Blackwell seconded the motion. Mrs. Oberer and Mrs. Huggins abstained and the other council members voted in favor of the motion. The minutes of the October 9, 2018 council meeting were accepted as prepared.

2. Citizen's and Visitor's Comments

There were no comments from any citizens or visitors in the audience.

3. Open Agenda

Mayor O'Callaghan read a thank you note to the Union Fire and Rescue and Union Police Departments from Gloria and Chuck Bramlage. Mrs. Bramlage thanked them for all the help she had received in the past and commented that if she had any problems in 2019 that she knew she would be in good hands.

The Mayor said he appreciated her note and said he would like to thank the City of Union citizens for passing the police levy in the recent November election. He said the passage of the levy would be very helpful.

Mayor O'Callaghan said the water main project on West Martindale Road was completed and the road looked very nice. He said he had heard from some of the residents and they were very happy with how the road looked.

He also reminded everyone of the Union tree lighting which would be held on November 25, at 6:00 p.m. The event is always held the Sunday evening after the Thanksgiving holiday.

Mayor O'Callaghan wished everyone a happy Thanksgiving, saying it was one of his favorite holidays, just family and friends getting together.

Mrs. Perkins thanked everyone that had voted and she said the voter turnout was very encouraging.

Mrs. Huggins said she agreed with all of the comments made regarding the road, passage of the police levy, and wishing everyone a happy Thanksgiving.

Mrs. Kyle said she was very happy that the water main project was finished and West Martindale Road was open.

Mr. Bruns said that fifty-two percent of the registered voters went out and voted which was very good. He said thanks to the Union residents for passing the police levy.

Mr. Bruns asked if there was anything pending for a second meeting in November. Mr. Applegate said not that he was aware of. Mr. Bruns moved that the November 26, 2018 Union council meeting be cancelled. Mr. Blackwell seconded the motion. All concurred and the motion was passed.

Mr. Bruns said the next council meeting would be on December 10th. He wished everyone a happy Thanksgiving.

Mr. Applegate said he was glad that the water main project on West Martindale was done also. He said they beat the bad weather by getting the project

completed when they did. He said the road looks good and that he has heard a lot of nice compliments about it.

Mr. Applegate said the next morning, they would be making their first major pour at the waste water treatment plant, for the aeration tanks. He said the project was moving along quite nicely.

Mr. Applegate said they had plenty of salt for the roads and they were ready for the bad weather.

Mrs. Winemiller informed the council that she had provided them with copies of the September and October fund sheets. She said September had a notation about amended appropriations and that should be added to the October fund sheet if the council could just make a note of that.

4. Mr. Bruns moved that the council meeting be adjourned. Mr. Blackwell seconded the motion. All concurred and the November 13, 2018 council meeting was adjourned.
