### Concerning Collection of the City's 1% Income Tax Effective 10/1/2015

The City of Union has contracted a new administrator to collect its 1% income tax effective 10/1/2015.

This change was necessary due to a recent, large increase imposed by the City of Vandalia for collection of our income tax. Vandalia will no longer collect Union's tax after 9/30/2015.

The Central Collection Agency, (CCA) is the new agency under contract to collect Union's income tax. CCA is a branch of the City of Cleveland's finance department with experience in collecting income tax for numerous jurisdictions. Copied on the reverse side of this page is a letter mailed to residents from CCA earlier this month.
