

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

MEETING OF COUNCIL

November 8, 2010

The City of Union council meeting was called to order by Mayor Goudy on Monday, November 8, 2010 at 7:30 p.m.

Attendance was taken and the following council members were present: Mr. Bruns, Mrs. Oberer, Mrs. Kyle, Mayor Goudy, Mr. O'Callaghan, Mr. Blackwell, and Mrs. Perkins.

Other city staff members attending the meeting were John P. Applegate, City Manager, Denise Winemiller, Assistant City Manager, and Joe Moore, Law Director.

Mayor Goudy called for a moment of silence.

1. Mayor Goudy asked if there were any additions or corrections to the council minutes from the October 25, 2010 council meeting. There were no corrections so Mr. Bruns moved to accept the council minutes as prepared. Mr. O'Callaghan seconded the motion. Mrs. Perkins abstained and the other council members voted in favor of the motion. The October 25, 2010 City of Union council minutes were accepted as prepared.

2. There were no comments from the citizens and visitors attending the meeting.

3. Open Agenda

Mayor Goudy asked how the city's leaf collection program was going. Mr. Applegate said it was going well and each week they had been able to get through the whole city within three days.

Mrs. Perkins asked if the city had investigated the cost of installing "Share the Road" signs that were proposed by Mary Laughter from Vandalia. Mr. Applegate was not present at that meeting and he said he would check into it and get back with the council.

Mr. Applegate said they were still working on the storm ditch and concrete channel at Irongate Estates. He suggested that the council go down Westrock and see what has been done.

Mr. Applegate said they were still working on the creek and clearing that out.

In response to a question from the council, the city crews are almost done putting up the Christmas lights and trimming the trees.

4. Mr. O'Callaghan moved that the November 8, 2010 council meeting be adjourned. Mr. Bruns seconded the motion. All concurred and the City of Union council meeting was adjourned.
