

# **RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS**

## **MEETING OF COUNCIL**

**September 27, 2010**

The City of Union Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Goudy on September 27, 2010, 7:30 Monday evening.

Attendance was taken and the following council members were present: Mr. Bruns, Mrs. Oberer, Mrs. Kyle, Mayor Goudy, Mr. O'Callaghan, Mr. Blackwell, and Mrs. Perkins.

Other city staff members present were John P. Applegate, City Manager, Denise Winemiller, Clerk of Council, and Joe Moore, Law Director.

Mayor Goudy called for a moment of silence.

1. Mayor Goudy asked if there were any corrections or additions to the council minutes of the September 13, 2010 council meeting. There were no corrections so Mr. Bruns moved to approve the minutes. Mrs. Oberer seconded the motion. Mr. Perkins abstained and the other council members voted in favor of the motion. The council minutes were accepted as prepared.

2. Mayor Goudy asked if there were any comments from the citizens and visitors in the audience.

There was a person that wished to address the council so Mayor Goudy recognized Ron Marlow. Mr. Marlow said he was from Phillipsburg but that he would be interested in doing towing for Union and would like to be listed on the towing company rotation.

Mayor Goudy asked Mr. Applegate if the city ever needed towing done. Mr. Applegate said the city seldom needed to use a towing service. The only time they needed that service was in case of a snow emergency when they occasionally had to have cars towed that were parked on the street. He said that he could check with the police chief. He thought that he had a list and that they usually used Englewood Towing and if they were busy, they would go to the next company on the list.

Mr. Marlow said that he works a lot in Englewood and Union and could get there within five to ten minutes. He also said he does have a secure storage area to store the vehicles.

Mrs. Winemiller asked Mr. Marlow to leave his business card.

3. ONE READING – RESOLUTION 10-12 – A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR.

Mr. Applegate said this was their annual housekeeping resolution for the tax levies. He said that the staff recommends the approval of this resolution.

Mr. Bruns moved to have the one and only reading and adopt Resolution 10-12. Mr. O’Callaghan seconded the motion. All concurred and Resolution 10-12 was adopted.

4. Open Agenda

Mayor Goudy and several other council members commented on how nice the city parking area was looking. Mr. Applegate said that they would be adding benches, lights, and landscaping to the area.

Mr. Blackwell asked why the handicapped parking space was in the back parking lot. Mr. Applegate said they needed two parking spaces and they had left one in the front area and one in the back area.

Mrs. Kyle asked when Beggars’ Night was and the date is Saturday, October 30, between 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.

Mr. Bruns reminded everyone that the next council meeting would be on Tuesday, October 12, because Monday is a holiday.

He also noted that the street levy for Union ends December 31, 2011. Mr. Applegate said that the street levy would be on the ballot in November.

In response to Mr. Bruns’ question, Mrs. Winemiller said there will be information concerning the street levy in the fall City of Union newsletter which will come out the third week of October.

5. Mr. O’Callaghan moved that the council meeting be adjourned. Mr. Bruns seconded the motion. All concurred and the council meeting was adjourned.
